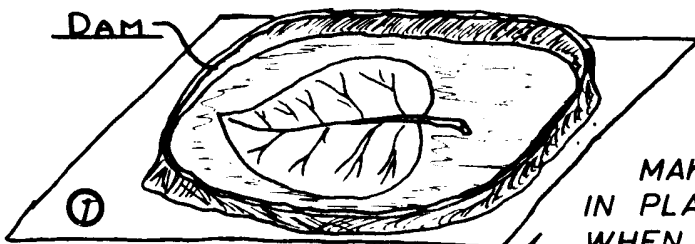

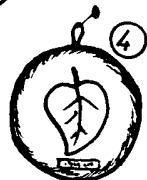
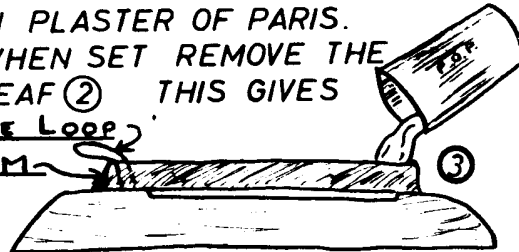


### PLASTER LEAF PLAQUES

- ① PLACE LEAF ON A BOARD WHICH HAS BEEN COATED WITH GREASE. RUB A LITTLE OF THE GREASE ON THE LEAF. MAKE A PLASTICINE DAM AND POUR IN PLASTER OF PARIS. WHEN SET REMOVE THE LEAF
- ② THIS GIVES

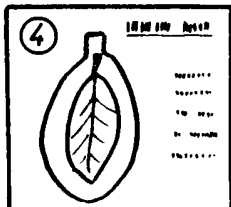
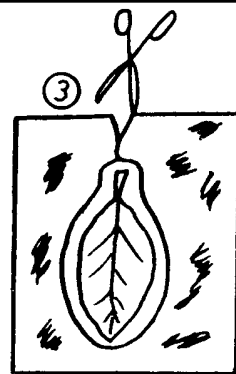
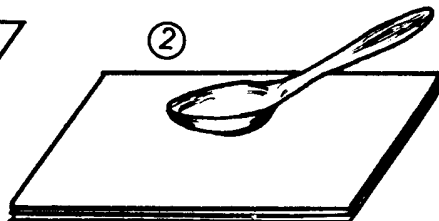
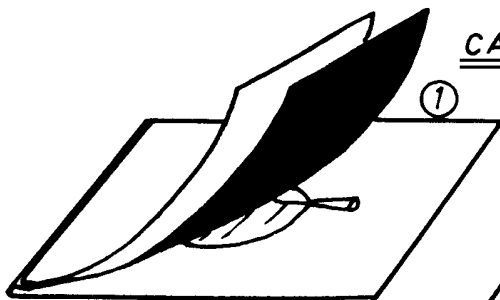


WIRE LOOP  
DAM



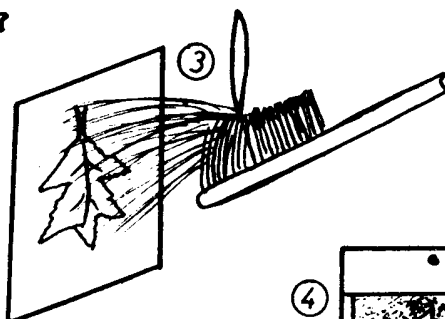
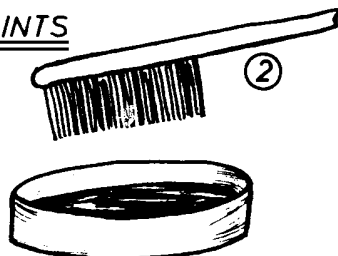
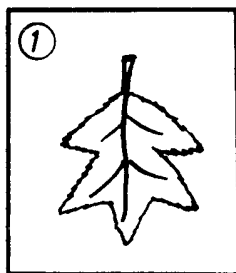
A MOULD FOR STEP ③ GREASE THE MOULD AND MAKE A DAM AS IN STEP ONE. MAKE A WIRE LOOP FOR HANGING. POUR IN PLASTER AND ALLOW TO SET. REMOVE PLAQUE, CLEAN IT AND COLOUR AS NEEDED. AND FINALLY LABEL IT. ④

### CARBON LEAF IMPRESSIONS



- ① Place leaf on a support—veins upwards—place carbon paper over the leaf with the carbon upwards. place a sheet of white paper on the carbon—
- ② Rub firmly but carefully with a spoon—
- ③ Cut the impression away from the smudges and mount it on a card or in a logbook and label it.

### LEAF SPATTER PRINTS



- ① Place leaf on a white card—secure with a spot of rubber cement—
- ② Make an ink pad of Indian ink and cotton wool—using an old tooth brush—dip this into the ink and with a piece of card "spatter" the ink over the leaf and card.
- ③ Remove card from leaf. A silhouette of the leaf will remain—mount and label
