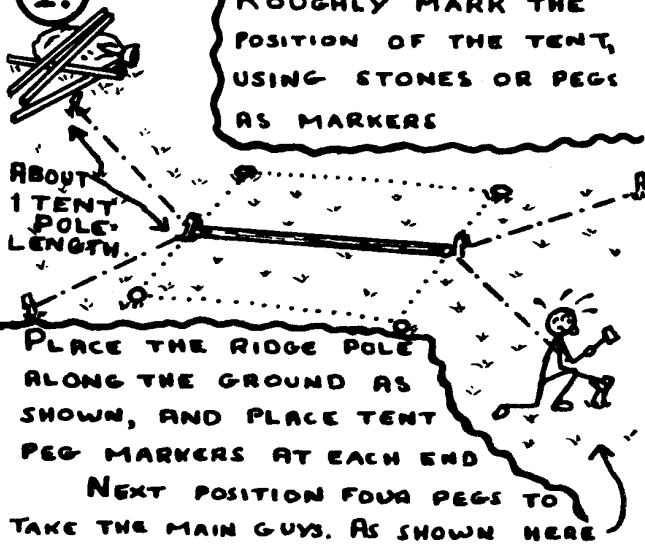


# PRO-PLAN CHART NO. 41.

## TENT PITCHING

1.



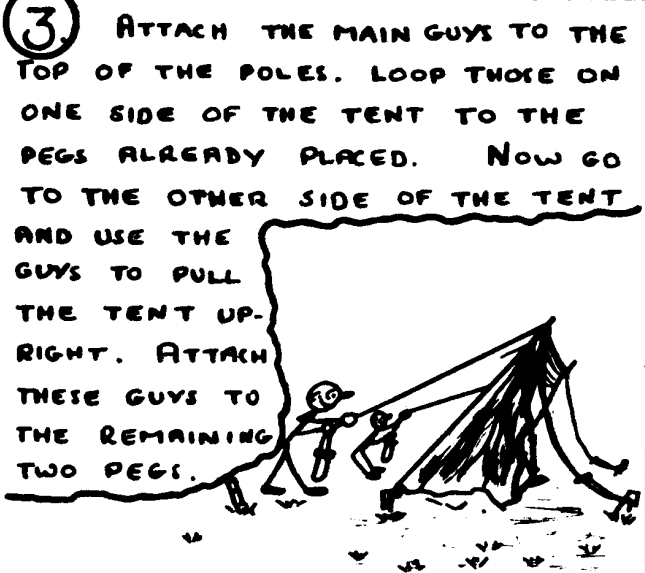
ROUGHLY MARK THE POSITION OF THE TENT, USING STONES OR PEGS AS MARKERS

GET THE TENT READY FOR PITCHING BY PUTTING THE UPRIGHTS AND RIDGE POLE INTO POSITION AND PLACE THE TENT ON THE GROUND WITH THE BASE OF THE UPRIGHTS AT THE MARKER PEGS.

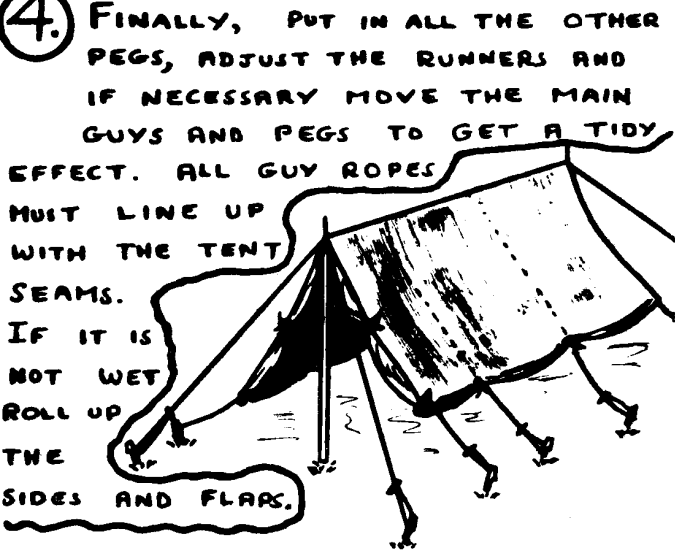

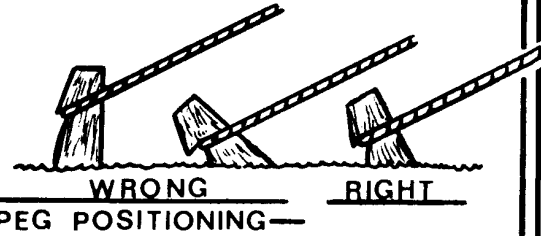
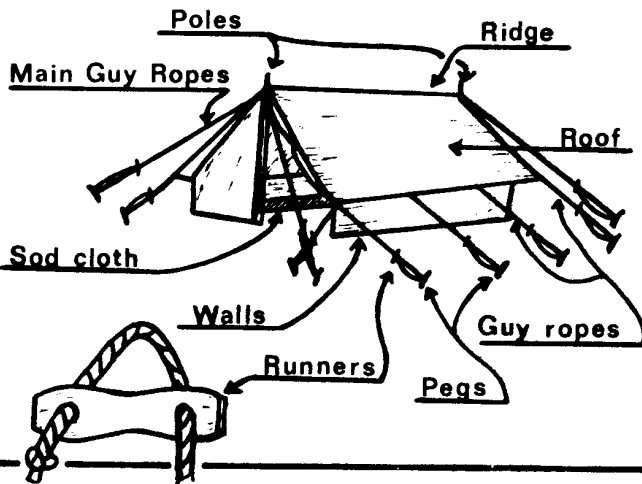
ATTACH THE MAIN GUYS TO THE TOP OF THE POLES. LOOP THOSE ON ONE SIDE OF THE TENT TO THE PEGS ALREADY PLACED. NOW GO TO THE OTHER SIDE OF THE TENT AND USE THE GUYS TO PULL THE TENT UP-RIGHT. ATTACH THESE GUYS TO THE REMAINING TWO PEGS.

FINALLY, PUT IN ALL THE OTHER PEGS, ADJUST THE RUNNERS AND IF NECESSARY MOVE THE MAIN GUYS AND PEGS TO GET A TIDY EFFECT. ALL GUY ROPES MUST LINE UP WITH THE TENT SEAMS. IF IT IS NOT WET ROLL UP THE SIDES AND FLAPS.

### RULES FOR TENT CARE

1. NEVER PUT AWAY A TENT IF WET
2. DO NOT DRAG THE POLES OVER THE CLOTH.
3. MAKE SURE THAT PEGS DO NOT PENETRATE THE CLOTH.
4. BEWARE OF INSECTS
