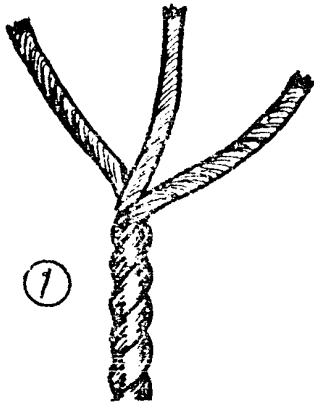


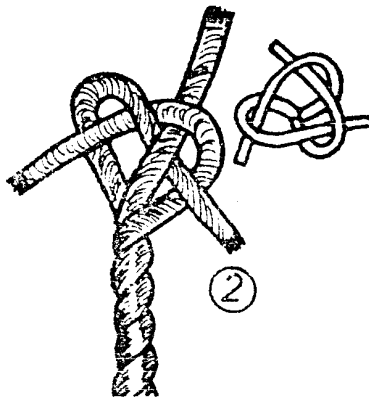

SPLICING 1

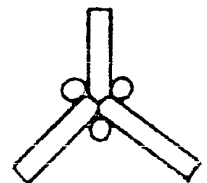
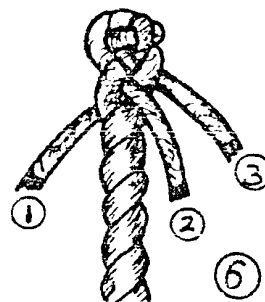
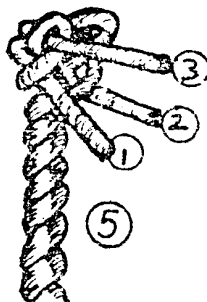
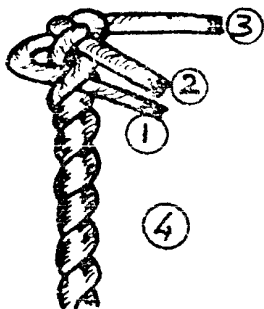
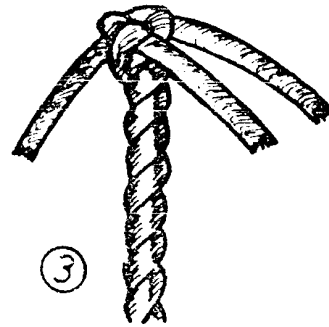
BACK SPLICE.



Unlay the rope for a distance of about six times its circumference

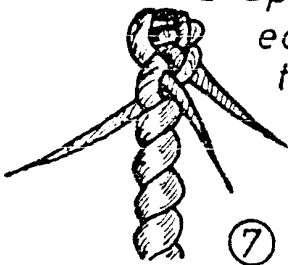


Make a crown knot and pull this tight



Start with one strand ~ take it over its own neighbour and under the following strand. Repeat with nos 2+3 and continue in the same way until the end is reached

Before ending a splice taper each strand to create a tidy finish



After completing a splice roll it under foot to make it smooth then singe off the fuzz.

NOTE! THE OVER AND UNDER METHOD OF LAYING THE STRANDS IS COMMON TO ALL SPLICING.
