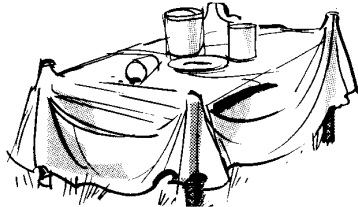

Plastic in camp

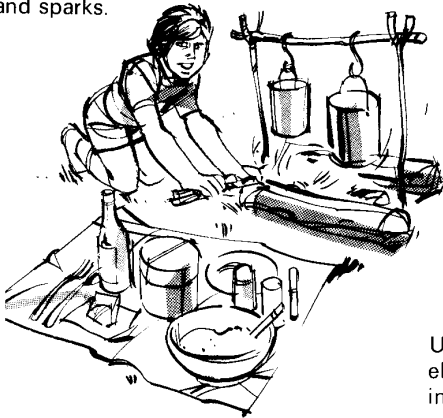


Use a plastic tablecloth to make cleaning up easier and cleaner.



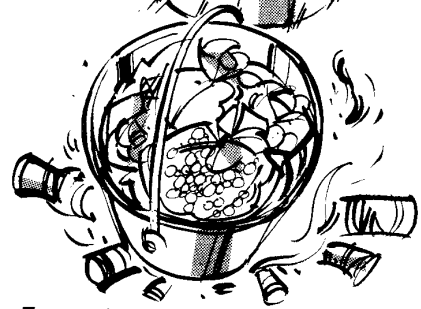
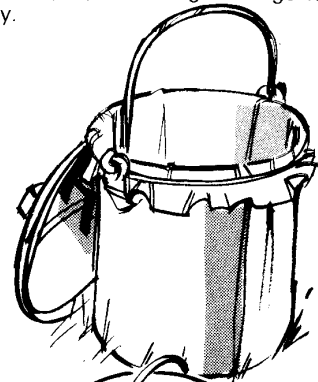
Keep food (e.g. butter) fresh by storing in polythene bags in a stream. (Remember to anchor them!)

Keep the plastic sheet away from the fire and sparks.



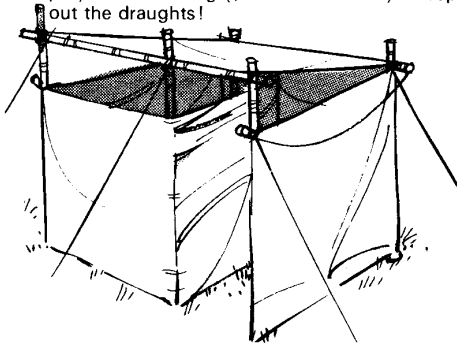
Use disposable plates and cups to eliminate washing-up! (Burn them instead of washing them).

Keep milk dixies clean by lining them with a polythene bag. Change it each day.

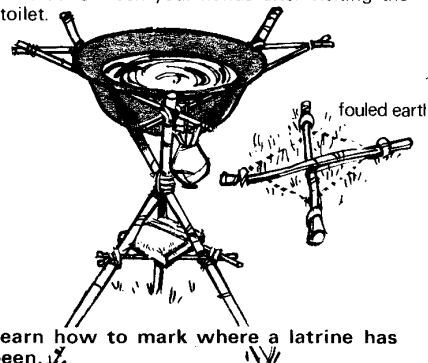


Try cooking by sealing your food in cooking bags (containing water if required) and boil the lot in a big dixie. Preserve the flavour, and reduce washing-up!

Why not make your lat screens out of heavy polythene sheeting (black or coloured)? Keep out the draughts!
